
LUCY DANIELS CENTER is the Triangle's largest nonprofit provider of children's mental health support and services. We help more than 600 children every year.

77 children were enrolled in Lucy Daniels School, a therapeutic day school for children in preschool–5th grade who need a nurturing, therapeutic academic setting in which to thrive.



587

806 children and families participated in therapy and evaluation through our on-site Farley Manning Family Guidance Service, which provides therapy for children ages 0–12 and their families. We provide guidance in identifying and addressing the root causes of each child's social and emotional difficulties and help in implementing successful strategies for their resolution.

587 children and families were connected with vital support and services through Lucy Daniels Center outreach programs, SecurePath, Circle of Security Parenting program, First Friends Social Skills program, Lucy's Link observation and assessment program, Lucy's Book Club, and parenting workshops and events.
